• • FANTASTIC NEW OFFER • •

As most of you know, we offer a **Chartwell Triple** riding package. This means that you get to ride the same horse 3 days per week and you get to compete that horse at interschools and other shows. This is a fantastic way to practice having your own horse without all the major expenses.

There are two separate rates for tripling:

Non-competitive tripler:

Ride the same horse or pony three days a week Compete in our Chartwell Training Shows No competing at outside shows Monthly Rate = R2950

Competitive tripler:

Ride the same horse or pony three days a week Compete in our Chartwell Training Shows You can compete at any outside shows of your choice. Monthly Rate = R3250

This added amount goes towards keeping vaccinations up to date as in order to be able to compete at outside shows, the horse or pony has to have an up to date passport signed by the vet for each standard vaccine, (Flu, AHS, Tetnus and Rabies) and the vaccines themselves need to be administered by a qualified vet.

AND NOW INTRODUCING:

•• THE CHARTWELL DOUBLE ••

This is similar to Tripling except you ride twice a week instead of three times and competitive Doublers may only compete at Inter-school shows and not all the outside shows.

This is a **good first step towards owning your own horse/pony** as you can start out Doubling, move on to Tripling and then look at getting your own.

There are two separate rates for the Chartwell Double:

Non-competitive Double:

Ride the same horse or pony two days a week Compete in our Chartwell Training Shows No competing at outside shows Monthly Rate = R1800

Competitive Double:

Ride the same horse or pony two days a week Compete in our Chartwell Training Shows Compete at Interschool Outside Shows. Monthly Rate = R2000

We are going to manage this new offer very carefully as we cannot have two riders doubling or tripling the same horse as it becomes tricky because interschools shows may fall on the same weekend but different schools compete at different venues and although our horses and ponies are very talented, they can't be at two different venues at the same time.
